

AFSCME Local 2725 / Maplewood Tentative Agreement 2026-2028

Your negotiating team has reached a Tentative Agreement with the recommendation to accept.

- 1. No take backs on any of the current articles. We did have attacks on heavy operating pay and comp. Your team did not back down.
- 2. **COLAs**: 2026 3%; 2027 3%; 2028 3%; with a comp study done for wage adjustments in 2029. The 3% will be given at once and not biyearly.
- 3. **Insurance** is now going to align with the other bargaining units. We do have if there is a 12% increase, we will open to bargain the effects of that to offset costs; 100% of paid medical leave is paid by employer with 2 new benefits being offered.
- 4. Remove senior service center rep as we don't have this position-
- 5. Official titles Sustainability Coordinator, Building Inspector II, Evidence Records Specialists
- 6. **Step adjustments** due to under air Market Records to step 7; Heavy Equipment Mechanic to 8; Mechanic Crew Chief to 9; Maintenance 1 will now follow through the 7 steps on the scale currently and move to the next grade closest to pay but not under after reaching 7th.
- 7. **Probation**: clean the language up, 12 months remains
- 8. **Out of class work language** change "shall be paid out at a higher rate but in no case less than a \$1.00."
- 9. **Expanded Language** on who is included in **Bereavement** leave to reflect ESST recognized language
- 10. **OT** prior to over 8 shall be approved by a supervisor
- 11. Added *Juneteenth* from MOU
- 12. Employer will **flex time** for schooling and **pay mileage** to and from the closest location. Example: if training is in Oakdale and you live in Forest Lake, mileage would start and end at Maplewood City Hall as it is the closest location to the school.
- 13. Mechanics received \$200 more for tools for 2026; in 2027 the employer will pay and maintain all tools.
- 14. Added: John Deer, Skidster, snow attachments to heavy equipment pay.
