Know your rights at work

Minnesota law gives you the right to take time off work to vote without losing pay or using vacation or personal leave.

Your employer can ask you to let them know when you'll be gone and coordinate with co-workers to minimize workplace disruptions, but they cannot interfere with your right to take the time you need to vote.
